# Getting to Know...*MR. SMITH (MUSIC AND BAND)*



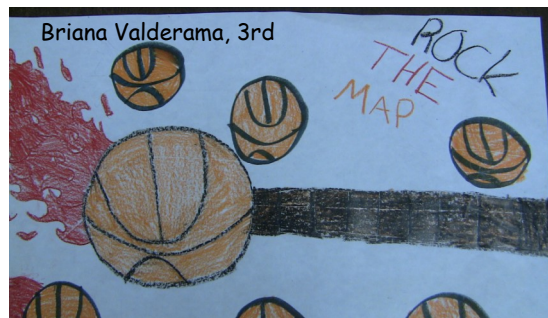

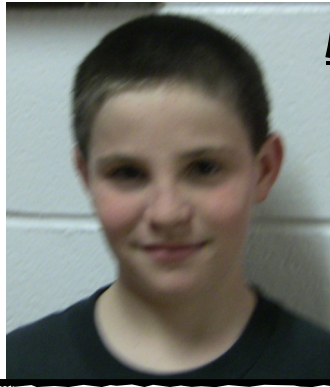

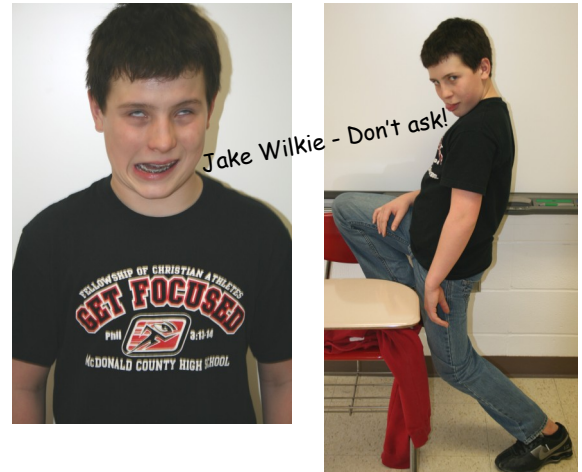
# Quotes, Jokes, and Mystery Folks

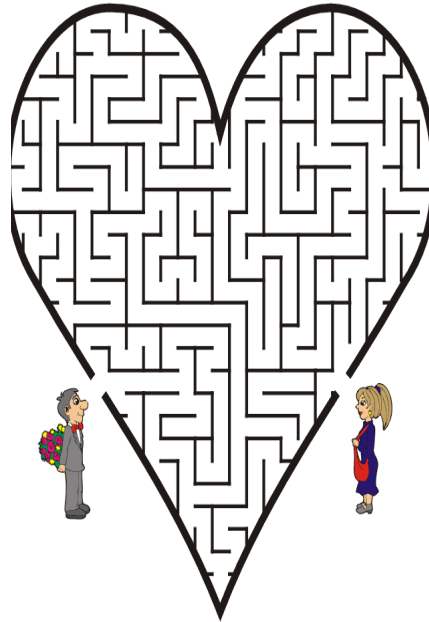
